In 2007 six of the eight Ashtabula County libraries established a consortium (ICAN: Independently Cooperating Ashtabula Network) to combine resources to better serve patrons while balancing a shrinking budget. These libraries are Andover Public Library, Conneaut Public Library, Harbor-Topky Memorial Library, Henderson Memorial Library, Kingsville Public Library and Rock Creek Public Library. In 2013 the ICAN consortium joined the stellar Clevnet system to offer over 10 million items. One Library card can be used at all 6 locations.
